**1 – KYVL and SREB Webinar**

KYVL was one of four virtual library consortia asked to participate in an SREB webinar for late October. The SREB (Southern Region Education Board) webinar entitled: "Virtual Libraries Can Save Your Job, School and Sanity!" addressed many issues including: Access, Interfaces, Journals and Magazines, Licensed Digital Content, Primary Resources, and Resources for Research.

All potential and current members were asked to return a signed letter of intent stating the acceptance of the FY2010-11 assessment. We've had very good response, with approximately 10 "no" responses across all groups. Unfortunately, there are still about 55 school districts which have not responded either way, with neither a "no" or a "yes." We will continue sending out reminders and updates via listservs and partners. We have a shortfall of about \$91,000 at this time.
