- The Kentucky Library Association Archives have been moved. They are now on the second floor of the Kentucky Department for Libraries and Archives, behind Talking Books.
- Most items in the Archives are organized by years, sections, round tables, etc. There is still work to be done in labeling and the next step of organizing within the sections, committees, and round tables.
- A call has gone out for additions to the archives. With the exception of Board documents and KLA publications, nothing has been added to the archives since the mid-eighties. The Academic Section has submitted some programs.
- During the year, I met with two trustees from the Paul Sawyer Library. They are working on the history of the Paul Sawyer Library for their 100th celebration. They are including material on Lilian Lindsey, the second president of KLA who was the founder of the Library.
