The Special Library Section has been engaged in the following activities since our last board meeting:

- Valerie Perry, SLS Listserv Manager, has updated the SLS listserv from the most recent membership list; adding 44 new subscribers; total number of subscribers is 109
- Special Library Section co-hosted the Kentucky Chapter's Welcome Reception during the Special Libraries Association's Leadership Summit held in January in Louisville, KY at the Louisville Slugger Museum. This reception gave our members an opportunity to network with colleagues from all over the world. There were several SLS members present, including KLA President, Fannie Cox and Jennifer Frazier, State Law Librarian, among others.
