Kentucky Library Association Board Meeting
December 8, 2007

Kentucky Public Library Association held its business meeting on September 20, 2007. Among other things, the members voted to continue the training for support staff across the state.

KPLA Annual Conference will be held April 16-18 in Bowling Green, KY. The conference planning is well under way. Mini-session proposals are being accepted until January 4.

UK Survey Research Center has finalized the survey on behalf of KPLA and the legislative committee. The results will be a remarkably valuable public relations tool for us. An official press release of the survey results is scheduled for December 17.

The Legislative Committee is also planning for Legislative Day which is to be held on February 13, 2008. Library directors, staff and advocates are encouraged to travel to Frankfort, meet their legislators and speak up on behalf of Kentucky's public libraries. Legislative committee members (and library directors) are currently arranging meetings with each of the library caucus members.
