Report to the Kentucky Library Association Board
November 18, 2009

The Community & Technical College Round Table presented a session called "What Can KCTCS Libraries Do for Your Library?" at the KLA/KSMA Joint Conference held at the Galt house on October 1st, 2009.

The C&TCRT session and follow-up round table meeting attendees were: Cherry Berges, Madisonville Community College; Terry D. Patrick Davison led the discussion. Nina Deeley and Terry Buckner participated. Our panel gave feedback about individual libraries, brief histories and descriptions of what the libraries did for distance education, online classes, programs and collaborations with public libraries in our area.

The Community & Technical College attendees discussed the Round Table charge for the coming year. Information Literacy was the major topic. The campus libraries want to create a line of communication, using the Internet, to share information, ideas and methods for teaching information literacy on the KCTCS campuses.

Patrick Davison has created a wiki and is in the process of setting up a distribution list of the C&TCRT members. Members will be able to post messages and documents.

Our KLA session attendees also suggested offering a PD session for future conference programming (speakers, workshops, etc.) about techniques and tools for teaching information literacy. It has also been suggested that the Community & Technical College Round Table could provide Profession Development for the Kentucky School Media Association (KSMA).
