Kentucky Library Association Board Meeting
September 14, 2010**

QUARTERLY REPORT

The Kentucky Public Library Association Executive Committee has not met since the June 2010 report. The next scheduled meeting is on September 15, 2010.

Advocacy Committee (JC Morgan, chair)

The committee held a retreat on September 2, 2010 at Shaker Village near Harrodsburg. The committee is focusing on creating a video to encourage awareness of library activities to be released in winter 2011. Additional "Support Kentucky's Public Libraries" cling stickers will be distributed at the 2010 KLA Conference in Louisville.

Awards Committee (Carrie Herrmann, chair)

The Committee will begin requesting applications for the next round of submissions soon.

Conference Planning Committee (Martha White, chair)

Martha White has begun planning for the 2011 KPLA Conference, April 11-13, at the Griffin Gate in Lexington.

Continuing Education Committee (Earlene Arnett, chair)

The Committee will be requesting information from the KDLA Regional Librarians about the use of their continuing education funds. The Committee will also be planning a statewide event at KDLA for early winter.

Intellectual Freedom Committee (Mark Adler and Ron Critchfield, co-chairs)

Julie Maruskin has resigned as co-chair of the Committee and was replaced by Ron Critchfield. The Committee has a meeting planned for this fall.

Public Relations Committee (Lisa Rice, chair)

New inserts for the KPLA informational brochure have been designed and will be distributed during the 2010 KLA Conference in Louisville. The Committee has also commissioned Gabrielle Gayheart to begin creating the KPLA website. The Committee has also identified a potential company to create a video promoting library awareness.

Standards Committee (Lisa Rice, chair)

Libraries have been asked to submit their completed scoring sheets for the KPLA Standards to Lisa Rice by October 1, 2010. The Committee will use the scores to create benchmarks among libraries that serve similar population sizes. A similar benchmark will also be created for the state as a whole.

The next business meeting of KPLA is on September 16, 2010 (Thursday) at 8am (EST) at the Galt House in Louisville.
