Re: KLA Youth Services Roundtable Annual Report

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This is the beginning of a transitional period for the Youth Services Round Table that seeks to encourage more involvement in KLA by everyone involved with serving youth by providing conference programs that clearly demonstrate KLA is thinking of this audience and wants leaders from this area involved with the association.

Goals for this year:

**Provide a variety and quantity of conference programs to encourage attendance.**

That goal has been met. Thanks to Debbe Oberhausen and Evie Topcik who suggested and helped secure an appealing schedule. There are conference programs during KLA and during KSMA that were provided with the support of the roundtable.

**Promote Youth Services Roundtable** to youth services professionals; encourage them to consider providing conference programs, KLA involvement, and to consider the possibility of taking on a leadership roles for the roundtable. Activities to support this goal include:

- Emails to KYAC, the youth services listserv supported by the Kentucky Department of Libraries and Archives
- JCPS summer institute: librarians promoted and discussed models for collaboration between school and public libraries as well as encouraged involvement in KLA.
- KSMA Summer Refresher: presentation by Roundtable Chair, Susan Moore, *The Power of Partnerships and School Support*. This presentation shared reasons to collaborate, exemplars from around the county, and encouraged school librarians to reach out to public librarians in their community and through KLA.
